## Armed Islamist gang terrorizing 'immoral' Chechen women in Berlin:

From the German edition of the Berlin daily reported on Wednesday after interviewing several victims. The newspaper has also seen a video made by the group and distributed within the capital's Chechen community.

In the video, a masked man points a gun at the camera. He claims that some Chechen women in Europe are doing "unspeakable" things, adding that "we will punish them" if the occasion presents itself. Claiming that the group has 80 members who have sworn their allegiance on the Quran, the man threatens: "We are coming onto the streets. Don't say you weren't warned. Don't say you didn't know." From a translation of the original report in German in on-line translation

Statistically, it is not possible to determine whether Chechens are more prominent because there is no Chechen citizenship. The Sunni people from the Caucasus also live not only in Chechnya, Russia, but also in Dagestan and Ingushetia — they have Russian passports. In addition, Chechnya come from Georgia, rarely from Kazakhstan. It is assumed that the Chechen war between the Muslim separatists and the Russian government contributed to the radicalization after the end of the Soviet Union.
