

Bill Maher: 'Fantasy' to think Muslim refugees will 'fit in' in Western countries

Maher is one of the few standard bearers of the left to seriously address the issue of Muslim immigration. The Democratic Party and the old Republican establishment think they can continue to pretend the problem doesn't exist. [reported](#).

He argued that "insisting that people around the world who are not like us, are going to be like us" is a mistake in thinking, and he said people are starting to realize that now.
