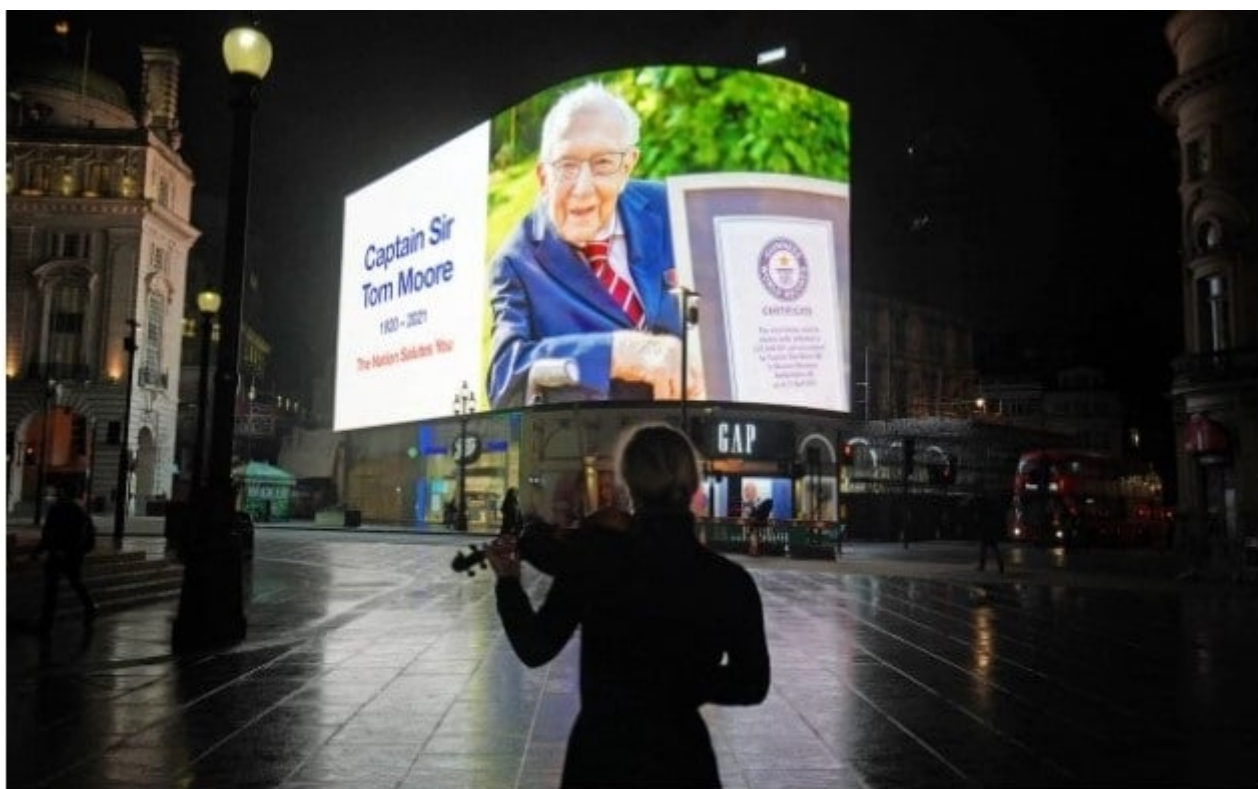


Captain Sir Tom Moore: Landmarks lit up to say farewell ahead of Clap for Tom at 6pm
