Wall Street Journalist Danny Pearl was on his way to a meeting with Jamaat ul-Fuqra (JF) founder, Sheik Mubarak Ali Gilani, a radical Sufi cleric, in Lahore, Pakistan on January 22, 2002. He was on the hunt for al Qaeda connections when he was abducted by four conspirators and allegedly killed by Al Qaeda mastermind of the 9/11 attack, Khaled Sheik Mohammed. As reported by the Georgetown University, Center for Public Integrity, Omar Sheik, a Britisheducated Pakistani, is in prison for Pearl's kidnapping and murder, as are three accomplices.
