

In Ottawa, Muslim Cleric Imtiaz Ahmad Is All For Free Speech, As Long As Religious Figures Are Off Limits

The Ahmadis are killed in Pakistan, for being Infidels who dare to consider themselves Muslims. They are not allowed, on official documents, to declare themselves to be Muslims. They are despised elsewhere, too, in the Muslim lands, and treated in many of them as hated “Qadianis” – the pejorative word for Ahmadis. The fanatical desire to be accepted keeps them calling themselves “Muslims” in the hope that someday they will be accepted as such. How much more sensible and logical for those born into Ahmadiyya Islam to jettison the whole thing altogether. After all, what has Islam ever done for anyone? What has it done for them?

Meanwhile, an Ahmadi cleric who lives in Canada (and for all I know has obtained Canadian citizenship, which as we all know no longer is an assurance that someone shares any of the loyalties or values or understandings that qualify someone to be called “Canadian” – or “American” or “French” or British”

any other Western nationality) says he's all for freedom of the press and speech, but only if an exception is made for religious figures – which means, of course, exemption for Muhammad. And without criticism of Muhammad, the Western world is even more vulnerable to its worst menace since the Nazis, and perhaps the worst in its entire history.
