ISIS Putting Price Tags on Iraqi Children, Selling Them as Slaves, U.N. Says

<u>Lt. Moath al-Kasasbeh</u>, burned to death. The Middle East nation hit back Thursday, unleashing fighter jets to ISIS strongholds in retaliation.

ISIS captured the 27-year-old after his F-16 fighter jet crashed near Raqqa on December 24. Even though the video came out this week, Jordanian authorities say they believe he was killed a month earlier.

The video of the pilot's burning seems to support the U.N.'s assertion.

In it, a young boy looks up as if in awe and says he would "burn the pilot" himself if he had a chance. "All Arab tyrants should also be burned," the boy says.

Since the video is carefully orchestrated propaganda, CNN has no way of knowing if the boy was coerced.
