Islamist suicide plot to assassinate Prime Minister Theresa May foiled

A terror plot to assassinate Prime Minister Theresa May has been foiled, <u>several weeks at least</u> by Scotland Yard, MI5 and West Midlands Police.

Naa'imur Zakariyah Rahman, 20, from north London, and Mohammed Aqib Imran, 21, from southeast Birmingham, are due to appear at Westminster Magistrates' Court on terror charges on Wednesday morning.

an official report into the Manchester terror attack revealed that the suicide bomber had been flagged for closer scrutiny by security services and that the atrocity could have been averted "had the cards fallen differently".

"Had the cards fallen differently" 22 women and girls, decent students and mothers, might still be alive with memories of a cracking night out; and some of the highest in the land, directly responsible for the policies that have brought sharia, jihad and razzia to our shores might have had a close and personal taste of what their policies are responsible for.
