Note particularly the statement by Cambadelis of the Socialist Party: "Les socialistes sont pour le traitement républicain de l'immigration, c'est-à-dire que l'on peut s'installer où on veut, quand on veut." That's the principle that should be applied to France, and to Western Europe, as the hordes arrive from North Africa and the Middle East? These immigrants cannot integrate.
