'Mother of Satan' explosive was used in July 7 terror attacks on London

From THE Parsons Green terrorist's real target could have been major London stations including Paddington and Westminster, according to terror experts. "We have to remember the terrorist is looking for maximum publicity and recognition worldwide. Unless you have been to Parsons Green, or you know someone there or are a Londoner you will not know it. Wimbledon, Notting Hill and Paddington — there are other destinations on that line that would have had much greater impact."

The tube train would have passed through busy stops including Earl's Court, High Street Kensington, Notting Hill Gate and Paddington. If the terrorist had changed to a City-bound train at Earl's Court, the bucket bomb could have also hit Victoria, Westminster and Monument.
