## Muslim teens arrested for blast at Sikh wedding in Germany

**BERLIN:** German police on Thursday arrested two teenagers with extremist backgrounds over an explosion that wounded three people at a Sikh temple, labelling it a "terrorist attack".

The blast that hit an Indian wedding party at the entrance to the temple in the western city of Essen last Saturday injured three men, one of them seriously.

Police arrested two 16-year-olds with known links to regional extremists over the attack, said city police chief Frank Richter. "We have to presume it was a terrorist act — religiously motivated terror by the extremist scene," Richter said in a statement, without linking the youths to a particular militant group. But I have never heard of Methodists being antagonistic and violent towards Sikhs — there is only one such religion. "Our work does not end with the arrest of the two suspects. There are numerous leads that need to be evaluated."

The young men thought to be responsible were "already known to the police for more" officers said. They identified the bombers after multiple tip offs in response to CCTV images that were released, the Westdeutsche Allgemeine Zeitung (WAZ)
