lost, the mood of voters has ranged from euphoric to suicidal.

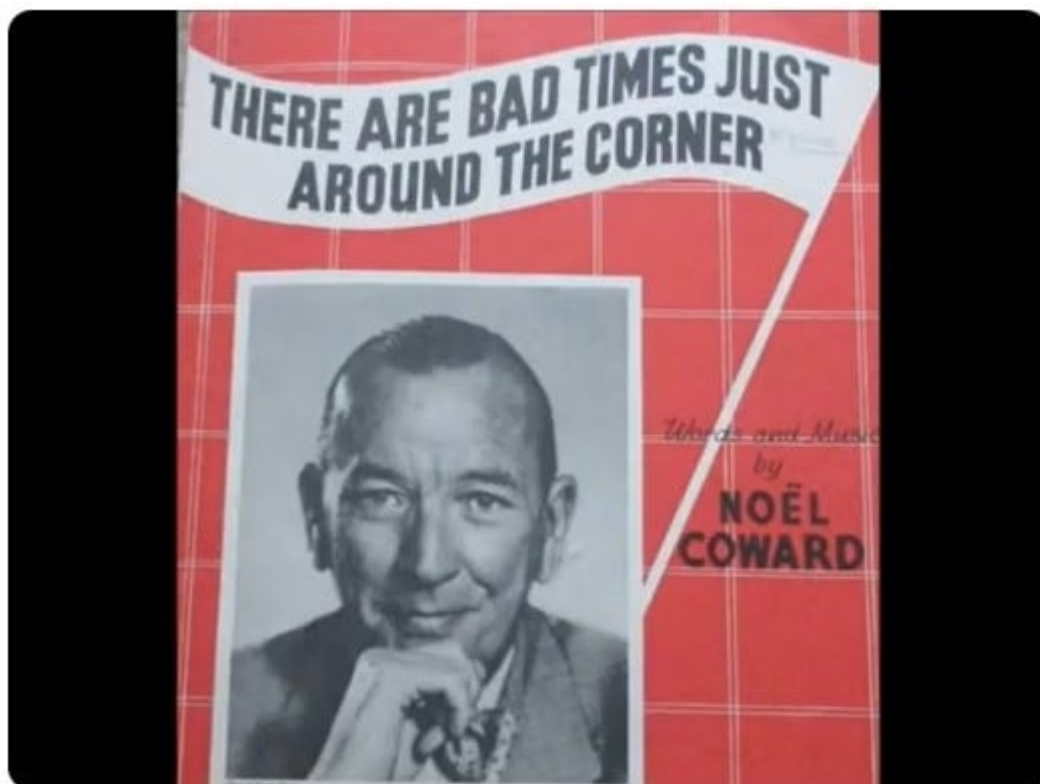
To avoid inflated expectations and hope instead to be
