'Pre-pubescent girls can be taken': ISIS publish guide on how to own a sex slave as the terror group uses an app to sell women and girls as young as 12

'Militants can own two sisters as concubines but only have sex with one.'

It also notes non-Muslim women can be used as sex slaves and that jihadis can own multiple women, but that they cannot be shared among ISIS fighters.

The women and girls, some as young as 12, are reportedly being sold at auction on a smartphone app.

According to a report by YJC, translated by <u>Daily Caller</u>, read: 'Virgin. Beautiful. 12 years old ... Her price has reached \$12,500 and she will be sold soon.'

Typically, women are being sold for between \$7,000 and \$7,500, according to IFP.

An activist in the Yazidi and Kurdish community told the Daily Caller its population had been the largest hit by ISIS' belief their fighters can take non-Muslim women as captive sex slaves

Around 3,000 women and girls are understood to be for sale

on the slave market and ISIS databases are shared with their checkpoints containing details of the women and their 'owners' to mitigate any chance of escape.
