

Several injured in 'bomb attack' on Armistice Day ceremony at Saudi cemetery

From [The BBC](#) understands one British person suffered minor injuries.

The government of Mecca province described the attack on the ceremony as "cowardly" and said security forces had launched an investigation.

"This morning, at the Jeddah Cemetery, a ceremony commemorating the end of World War I was the target of an improvised explosive device attack," said [tweeted photographs showing the aftermath](#) of the bombing, including one appearing to show an injured person receiving treatment.



“Attempted attack this morning at the non-Muslim cemetery in Jeddah. During the #11November ceremony. In the presence of the consuls-general of France, [Ireland], [Britain]... and French expatriates,” she wrote. “There are wounded... [13] days after the knife attack at the consulate, France targeted once again!?”
