

Somali man arrested after three killed in knife attack in Germany; Update, witness heard him shout Allah Akbar

Officers are also searching his home and investigating his contacts for further evidence. A witness reported that the suspect shouted "Allah Akbar" during the attack, said Mr Herrmann. But a police spokesman said that, while the attacker had a criminal record, none of his previous offences were related to terrorism.

Video footage circulating online showed passersby trying to stop the suspect using folded chairs. A crowd of people gave chase, before a police car arrived on the scene. The mass-circulation daily Bild published a photo of the suspect, showing a man wearing a beige, long-sleeved t-shirt with grey trousers and holding a long knife.

Police said on Twitter that there was no danger to the population. *Until next Friday.*
