Tommy Robinson has handed his X account over to trusted admins. He returned to England earlier this week and was required to report to the police at 3pm this afternoon. Now he is in custody the admins will keep the public updated.

ADMIN POST - IMPORTANT UPDATE

Tommy has been remanded into prison for a breach of the terrorism act - because he refused to give police the code to gain access into his phone.

It is worth noting that Tommy held information of child rape victims on his phone, which he told the police at the time, and as they are 'confidential journalistic sources' they had no right to snoop or gain information about them.

Tommy has a duty of care to ALL of his sources, as does any other journalist.

Tommy has relinquished his X account to admins so we can keep you informed and updated with news as and when it breaks as his request.

We can confirm that Tommy is now being held on remand until Monday where he will appear at Woolwich Crown Court at 10am.



Tommy said earlier that tomorrow's rally is all organised and WILL take place, with or without him in person. It's going to be an interesting day.

Update from the Admins

Just to clear up any confusion, Tommy has been remanded into custody until Monday for his CONTEMPT hearing. The court hearing could conclude that day, or possibly the day after. Tommy is due to appear in court on November the 13th to answer to terrorism charges – for not giving the police his pin and full access into his phone which has privileged journalistic information on it. This does not make Tommy a terrorist, it makes him an ethical journalist, one who protects his sources.

And one last clarification for now, Tommy has been charged under Schedule 7 of the Terrorism Act.
