

Yossi Cohen for Prime Minister of Israel?

In the raid in January 2018 that was organized by Mossad on the warehouse in Tehran, where Iran's nuclear archive was stored, time was of the essence. The Mossad operatives had at most seven hours in which to break into the warehouse, to unlock or blast open 32 steel containers, to empty them of what turned out to be 50,000 documents and 163 tapes, to study their contents and to decide what documents would be sent digitally to Mossad in Tel Aviv, and which were less important, and could await their physical delivery.
